By Mr. Curtiss of Sheffield, petition of Sidney Q. Curtiss for the payment from the state treasury of a certain sum of money to the town of Otis for the payment of a part of the cost of construction of an addition to its schoolhouse. Ways and Means (House).

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE TOWN OF OTIS OF PART OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO ITS SCHOOLHOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to
2 the town of Otis such sums as would have been due said town
3 from the commonwealth in an application for a state school
4 construction grant for the construction by said town of an addition
5 to its schoolhouse completed in the year nineteen hundred and
6 seventy had been filed by said town and approved by the board of
7 education under the provisions of chapter six hundred and forty-
8 five of the Acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as amended.
9 Said board shall determine the amounts and the time of said
10 payments, and shall certify the same to the comptroller as provided
11 in said chapter six hundred and forty-five, and the treasurer shall
12 make the payments so certified to said town.
