AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY OF A VACANCY OR NEWLY CREATED NON-CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after 25A the following section: —

3 *Section 26.* At least thirty days prior to the filling of any vacan-
4 cy, not subject to civil service laws and rules, in any department of
5 the commonwealth or the appointment of any person to a newly
6 created position not subject to the civil service law and rules, there
7 shall be a notice posted in each of the various offices of the division
8 of employment security of the commonwealth. The notice shall
9 state the position to be filled, the qualifications and salary therefor,
10 and the place to which application for said position should be
11 made; provided, however, that where in the opinion of the secre-
12 tary of administration and finance, the orderly operation of state
13 government would be substantially impaired by the postponement
14 in filling the vacancy, said secretary shall authorize the temporary
15 filling of such vacancy.
