AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for carrying out the Provisions of the Acts Relating to the Employment of Labor in the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of two hundred and
2 twenty-five thousand dollars is hereby appro-
3 priated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for
5 maintaining industries at the state prison during
6 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, the
7 same to be in addition to the amounts appropri-
8 ated by chapter one hundred and five of the acts
9 of the present year. [Acts 1887, chap. 447; 1888,
10 chap. 403.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$260,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
