AN ACT REQUIRING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO PAY PETER J. POWILATIS THE AMOUNT OF MONEY HE WOULD HAVE RECEIVED FOR HIS ACCRUED VACATION TIME UPON HIS RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 chusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall pay to Peter J.
- 3 Powilatis, a retired employee of said authority, the amount of
- 4 money he would have received had he been paid for all his
- 5 accrued vacation time when he retired.
