AN ACT PROVIDING A SOURCE OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY FOR THE TOWN OF SOUTHBOROUGH FROM A CERTAIN AQUEDUCT TO BE CONSTRUCTED BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Southborough is hereby authorized
2 to take water for the use of said town and its in-
3 habitants from the pressure aqueduct to be con-
4 structed by the metropolitan district water supply
5 commission from a point on the Wachusett aqueduct
6 of the metropolitan water district at or near the
7 terminal chamber, so called, in the city of Marl-
8 borough, to a point on the Weston aqueduct of said
9 district near its Sudbury dam in the said town of
10 Southborough, under the provisions of chapters four
11 hundred and sixty and five hundred and one of the
12 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.
