AN ACT

Relative to the date of Filing or Recording Certain
Papers in Registries of Deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 All papers presented for record or filing in any
- 2 registry of deeds, after the hour of five o'clock in
- 3 the afternoon, shall be entered or placed on file
- 4 as of the hour of nine o'clock in the morning of
- 5 the next opening of the registry.
