AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF FIRE PREVENTION REGULATIONS AND THE BOARD OF BUILDING REGULATIONS AND STATISTICS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 22D of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition is hereby  
3 amended by striking the word “thirteen” in line 8 and substituting  
4 in place thereof the word:— fourteen.

1 SECTION 2. Section 4 of Chapter 22D of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking the  
3 word “ten” in line 18 and substituting in place thereof the word:—  
4 eleven.

1 SECTION 3. Section 4 of Chapter 22D of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
3 between the words “public” and “one”, in line 26, the words:—  
4 one of whom shall be an inspector of buildings in a town or city..

1 SECTION 4. Section 93 of Chapter 143 of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking the  
3 word “eleven” in line 5 and substituting in place thereof the  
4 word:— twelve.

1 SECTION 5. Section 93 of Chapter 143 of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking the  
3 word “nine” in line 9 and substituting in place thereof the word:—  
4 ten.

1 SECTION 6. Section 93 of Chapter 143 of the Massachusetts  
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking, in  
3 lines 16 and 17, the words “one of whom shall be a head of a local  
4 fire department” and substituting, in place thereof, the following  
5 words:— one of whom shall be the head of the fire department of  
6 a city, one of whom shall be the head of a fire department of a  
7 town.
