AN ACT PROHIBITING ELECTRIC COMPANIES FROM SELLING LIGHTING FIXTURES AND SUPPLIES AT RETAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 164 of the General laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 94G the following section: —

3 *Section 94H.* No electric company shall sell at retail any electri-
4 cal lighting fixtures or related supplies. Violation of the provisions
5 of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than one
6 hundred dollars, and each such violation shall constitute a separate
7 offense.
