AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE UNIFORMS OF SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 No Special Police Officer, licensed by the Commissioner of
- 2 Public Safety, Police Commissioner or Chief of Police of any city
- 3 or town shall wear a uniform identifiable to that worn by a Police
- 4 Officer in the city or town in which said Special Officers are
- 5 working.
