## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT REMOVING THE LIMIT ON THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH MAY BE EXPENDED FOR PLANNING BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 425 of the Acts of 1963, as most recently amended by  
2 Chapter 1191 of the Acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by  
3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof, the  
4 following new sentence:—The county commissioners of the  
5 County of Franklin may, for the purpose of protecting the  
6 interests of said county and to provide for land use planning and  
7 the economic development thereof, expend such sums as may be  
8 appropriated therefor, provided that any monies expended for  
9 travel expenses shall be allocated from the voluntary con-  
10 tributions, either public or private, which were deposited in said  
11 treasury for the purposes of said commission.
