

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 138, 139.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 151A of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 289 of the acts of 1976, is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- A dog officer having custody of a confined dog shall be allowed the sum of three dollars per day for the care of such dog, payable by the owner or keeper thereof, if known, otherwise from the dog fund.

SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section 151A of said chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- A dog officer having custody of a confined dog shall be allowed the sum of three dollars per day for the care of such dog, payable by the owner or keeper thereof, if known, otherwise from the dog fund.

Chap. 138. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE HAMPSHIRE COUNTY HOUSE OF CORRECTIONS IN THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON AS THE SHERIFF JOHN F. BOYLE BUILDING.

The main building to be constructed at the Hampshire county jail and house of correction, in the city of Northampton, shall, upon its completion, be designated and known as the Sheriff John F. Boyle Building, in honor of Hampshire county sheriff John F. Boyle.
