## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE FISH AND GAME BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 7 and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 7.* The division of fisheries and game shall be under  
5 the supervision and control of the fish and game board,  
6 hereinafter called the board, which shall consist of five mem-  
7 bers to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and  
8 consent of the council. Upon the expiration of the terms of  
9 office of the present members of said board, their successors  
10 shall be appointed for a term of five years by the governor,  
11 with the advice and consent of the council. Such board  
12 members shall consist of one person appointed at large from  
13 each of the five wildlife districts.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out in line four of section 7A the word  
3 “county” and inserting in place thereof the words “wildlife  
4 district.”
