## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BELLINGHAM TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINES AND MALT BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter  
2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing  
3 authority of the town of Bellingham is hereby authorized to issue  
4 to Paul and Bonnie Grimala, d/b/a Paul's Variety Store, a license  
5 for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the  
6 premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter  
7 one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all  
8 the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except  
9 said section seventeen.
