

HOUSE No. 2809

By Mr. Condon of Boston (by request), petition of the Boston Police Relief Association that police officers of the city of Boston be paid for one half the number of unused accumulated sick leave days due them upon retirement or death. Public Service.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT TO POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR HALF THE NUMBER OF UNUSED ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE DAYS UPON THE RETIREMENT OR DEATH OF SAID OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, a police officer of the city of Boston whose
3 service is terminated by retirement or death without his having
4 used all his sick leave, shall be compensated for one half of the
5 number of sick-leave days accumulated, or in case of his death,
6 his beneficiary, at the regular rate of compensation payable to
7 him at the time of his retirement or death.

8 The word "beneficiary" as used in this section means the
9 surviving beneficiaries or beneficiary, if any, lawfully designated
10 by the employee under the retirement system of which he is a
11 member, or, if there be no such designated beneficiary, the estate
12 of the deceased.
