

HOUSE No. 2351

By Mrs. Gilligan of Lynn, petition of Julie Gilligan for legislation requiring the dates of freezing on labels of certain foods. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL FROZEN FOOD SHALL BE LABELED AS SUCH AND THE DATE OF FREEZING SHALL BE PRINTED ON THE LABEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 73A the following section: —

3 *Section 73B.* No person shall sell, or represent for the
4 purpose of sale, otherwise than as frozen, food which has been
5 frozen. All food which has been frozen shall be so labeled
6 and in addition the date of freezing shall be printed on said
7 label. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a
8 fine of not less than twenty-five nor more than fifty dollars.
