

Chap. 449. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WESTFIELD TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO THE WIDOW OF HAROLD WHITEMORE, THE FORMER CITY CLERK OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good, the city of Westfield is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay to Dessie M. Whittemore, widow of Harold Whittemore, the former city clerk of said city, so long as she remains unmarried, an annuity in the sum of twelve hundred dollars to be paid in equal monthly instalments.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city of Westfield.

Chap. 450. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A DECREE FOR SEPARATE SUPPORT MAY REQUIRE THAT ONE OF THE PARTIES SHALL BE REQUIRED UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES TO MAKE A CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 209 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 32C the following section:—

Section 32D. Whenever in any proceeding under section thirty-two a decree shall be entered directing that a deed, conveyance or release of certain real estate, or interest therein, be made, such decree shall create an equitable right to its enforcement subject to the provision for recording of notice in section fifteen of chapter one hundred and eighty-four, in the party entitled thereto by the decree, and if the decree has not been complied with within three months after said decree has been entered and a certified copy of said decree is recorded or registered in the manner provided by section forty-four of chapter one hundred and eighty-three, then the decree itself shall operate to vest title to the real estate or interest therein in the party entitled thereto by the decree as fully and completely as if such deed, conveyance or release had been duly executed by the party directed to make it, and so recorded.

Chap. 451. AN ACT DEFINING THE WORD "CLINIC" AS IT REFERS TO CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 2B of chapter 155 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:— For purposes of this section, the word "clinic" shall have the same meaning as is set forth in section fifty-two of chapter one hundred and eleven, except that it shall not include a professional corporation established under chapter one hundred and fifty-six A, unless such corporation is actually operating a clinic.
