AN ACT CHANGING THE TIME OF HOLDING THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING AND TOWN ELECTION OF THE TOWN OF STOUGHTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The annual town meeting of the town
2 of Stoughton shall be held on the first Monday in
3 March at eight o'clock in the evening, and all matters
4 to be considered at the annual town meeting shall be
5 considered at such meeting, except that the annual
6 town election for the purpose of electing, by official
7 ballot, town officers and voting on any question re-
8 quired by law to be placed upon the official ballot,
9 shall take place at an adjournment of such meeting
10 to be held on the third Monday in March.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
