

SENATE No. 236

To accompany the petition of Edward C. Carroll for legislation to prohibit members of the finance commission of the city of Boston from engaging in or being connected with certain activities. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act prohibiting Members of the Finance Commission of the City of Boston from engaging in or being connected with Certain Activities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No member of the finance commission of the
2 city of Boston shall, during his term of office,
3 act as or be a director, officer or shareholder of
4 any national banking association, or of any
5 trust company, savings bank, institution for
6 savings or co-operative bank, doing business
7 within the commonwealth, or of any association
8 or corporation of the types known as investment
9 companies or public utilities corporations; nor
10 shall any such member act as counsel, or be
11 otherwise involved, directly or indirectly, in
12 the matter of any claim or litigation of any
13 nature involving the city of Boston.
