

HOUSE No. 458

Accompanying the petition of Albert C. Goff that town clerks be required to certify to town treasurers appropriations made at town meetings. Municipal Finance. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

To require a Town clerk to Certify Appropriations made by the Town at Town Meetings to the Treasurer of the Town.

1 *Whereas*, The holding of many town meetings, on and
2 about the date of the passage of this act, would postpone
3 the operation and consequent benefit of this act, unless
4 it is made to take effect forthwith, this act is declared
5 an emergency act within the purview of the law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Forthwith upon the adjournment of a town meeting,
2 the town clerk shall certify to the town treasurer, the
3 board of assessors, and accounting officer, if any, each
4 and every appropriation of monies made by vote of the
5 town, specifically and in detail.
