AN ACT REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN PRESCRIPTIONS BE KEPT ON FILE
IN CERTAIN PHARMACIES FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN THREE
YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 187 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following
3 paragraph after the paragraph defining written prescription:—
4 All prescriptions dispensed by a pharmacist shall be kept on
5 file in the pharmacy in which they have been filled¹ for a period
6 of not less than three years.
