

SENATE No. 132.

[To accompany the petition of Charles H. Hastings, president of the Lynn Board of Trade and others, for the construction of the state highway laid out by the Massachusetts highway commissioners between the Saugus river and Commercial street in the city of Lynn. Roads and Bridges.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To provide for the Construction of the State Highway laid out by the Massachusetts Highway Commissioners between the Saugus River and Commercial Street in the City of Lynn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts highway com-
2 mission is hereby authorized and instructed to
3 construct in the year nineteen hundred and one
4 so much of the state highway as is laid out
5 between the bridge authorized by chapter five
6 hundred and forty-seven of the acts of the

7 year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight over
8 Saugus river between the city of Lynn and the
9 town of Revere and Commercial street in said
10 Lynn, as per plans made by said state highway
11 commission on file in the city clerk's office of said
12 city of Lynn dated April twenty-seventh, eighteen
13 hundred and ninety-nine, and August twenty-
14 fourth, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts highway com-
2 mission is hereby authorized to expend a sum not
3 exceeding one hundred thousand dollars for the
4 construction of said portion of said state highway
5 in accordance with the provisions of existing laws
6 relative to the construction of state highways.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of meeting ex-
2 penses that may be incurred under section three
3 of this act, the treasurer and receiver-general is
4 authorized to proceed in the manner prescribed
5 in and subject to the provisions of chapter three
6 hundred and ninety-six of the acts of the year
7 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
