AN ACT TO MAKE A DECREE FORECLOSING THE RIGHT OF REDEMPTION OF A TAX TITLE CONCLUSIVE UPON ALL PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter sixty of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section seventy-five the  
3 following new section, section seventy-five A:—  
4 *Section 75A.* A decree of foreclosure entered under  
5 the provisions of sections sixty-four to seventy-five  
6 inclusive shall be conclusive as to the validity of the  
7 tax title and shall be conclusive upon and bar redemp-  
8 tion by all persons, including the commonwealth,  
9 whether included in the petition, notice or caption,  
10 or included in the general description “to all whom it  
11 may concern.”
