RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES RELATIVE TO ACQUIRING ADDITIONAL LAND IN THE VICINITY OF THE BOXFORD WILD LIFE RESERVATION, BOXFORD STATE FOREST AND HAROLD PARKER STATE FOREST.

1 *Resolved*, that the Department of Natural Resources make
2 an investigation and study of current house document num-
3 bered 759, authorizing and directing the department of natural
4 resources to acquire additional land in the vicinity of the Box-
5 ford Wild Life Reservation, Boxford State Forest and Harold
6 Parker State Forest. Said department shall report to the gen-
7 eral court the results of its investigation and study and its re-
8 commendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
9 necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing
10 the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the last
11 Wednesday of December in the current year.
