AN ACT RELATING TO COUNTY FUNCTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 64D of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 a new section: —
- 3 Section 14. The county commissioners or a majority of towns
- 4 and cities in a county with no county government shall vote up to
- 5 10% of the county deeds excise funds to be distributed pro rata to
- 6 each public library in their county.
