Mr. Hilton moves that this bill be substituted by amendment for the report of the committee on Railroads, reference to the next General Court, on certain petitions for legislation relative to rates of fare for the transportation of passengers.

AN ACT

Relative to Monthly Railroad Tickets between Certain Points within the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In place of issuing tickets good for
2 sixty trips to be used within one month from the
3 date of issue, every railroad corporation, except
4 the Boston, Revere Beach and Lynn Railroad Com-
5 pany, operating passenger cars over any railroad
6 within the commonwealth, shall, from and after the
7 date when this act takes effect, issue tickets for
8 passage between points within the commonwealth
9 good for fifty-four trips within one month from the
10 date of issue and the charge therefor shall be not
11 more than nine tenths of the charge now made for
12 said sixty-trip tickets.

1 SECTION 2. Every railroad corporation, except
2 the Boston, Revere Beach and Lynn Railroad Com-
3 pany, operating within this commonwealth shall
4 place on sale at all regular stations within the com-
5 monwealth where ordinary tickets are for sale, sup-
6 plies of fifty-four-ride tickets good during thirty
7 business days, and any corporation failing so to sup-
8 ply any applicant therefor with such fifty-four-trip
9 ticket at any such regular station shall cause to be
10 issued to such applicants evidence of payment of
11 fare which shall be credited to such applicant in the
12 purchase of such fifty-four-ride ticket at such place
13 as he may be obliged to obtain such ticket.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first
2 day of July, in the year nineteen hundred and thir-
3 teen.
