AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO REMOVE ANY OBSTACLE AND CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN AN ENTRANCE FOR VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS FROM WINTHROP PARKWAY TO ROUGHAN STREET IN THE CITY OF REVERE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to set aside the agreement of November  
3 seventh, nineteen hundred and sixty-three by and between the  
4 metropolitan district commission commissioners and Ben Ford  
5 Abrams. The metropolitan district commission is further di-  
6 rected to remove electric light pole and any other barrier and  
7 construct and maintain an entrance thirty feet in width for  
8 vehicles and pedestrians from Winthrop parkway to Roughan  
9 street in the city of Revere. All work to be done in accordance  
10 with metropolitan district commission plan 42240 and in con-  
11 formance to the details shown on the plan and to the lines-  
12 grades-and specifications defined.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of this act the metropolitan dis-  
2 trict commission may expend such sums as may be appropriated  
3 therefor.
