AN ACT RELATIVE TO FIRST ASSISTANT REGISTERS IN THE PROBATE AND FAMILY COURT DEPARTMENT OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of Chapter 217 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: — The judges of the probate and family court
5 department for each county may appoint and may remove a first
6 assistant register of probate under the procedures authorized by
7 Section 8 of Chapter 211B.
