### AN ACT PROVIDING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR HAMPSHIRE COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the  
2 current appropriation act for Hampshire County, the following  
3 sums are hereby appropriated, subject to the provisions of law  
4 regulating the disbursement of county funds and the approval  
5 thereof, for the fiscal year Nineteen Hundred and Eighty-Two.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the  
2 contrary the Treasurer of Hampshire County is hereby authorized,  
3 with the approval of the County Commissioners, to expend the  
4 total amount appropriated in section one from any available funds,  
5 including federal revenue sharing funds, in the treasury of the  
6 County.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
