AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED BY THE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 in administering a scholarship program in accordance with the
- 4 provisions of section one D of chapter fifteen of the General
- 5 Laws, with the particular purpose of providing a greater
- 6 number of scholarships for students of parents of "low in-
- 7 come", as defined by the commissioner of education.
