RESOLVE

Providing for the Printing of the Laws relating to Elections.

1 *Resolved*, That the secretary of the Commonwealth
2 shall cause to be prepared and printed five thousand
3 copies of a pamphlet containing the acts passed at the
4 present session, relating to elections, together with the
5 provisions of the Public Statutes and other laws now in
6 force relating to elections. with proper notes and refer-
7 ences and a complete index in such form as may be con-
8 venient for preservation and use in the several cities and
9 towns of the Commonwealth; one copy to be furnished
10 to each member of the present legislature, and as many
11 copies to each city and town clerk as shall be necessary
12 to enable him to retain one copy for his own use, one
13 copy in his office for the use of the public, and to furnish
14 two copies for the use of the board of registrars of voters
15 and two copies for the use of the election officers in each
16 voting precinct.
