In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To Legalize and Confirm the Proceedings of the Annual
Town Meeting of the Town of Melrose.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The election of town officers for the town
2 of Melrose, at the annual town meeting of said town held
3 on the first day of March, in the year eighteen hundred
4 and ninety-seven, shall not be invalid by reason of the
5 fact that the clerk pro tempore of said meeting was not
6 elected as required by law, and all acts of said meeting
7 are hereby confirmed and made legal and valid.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
