AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITIONS OF BUILDING COMMISSIONER AND BUILDING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The positions of building commissioner and building inspector
- 2 in the town of Tewksbury shall be exempt from the provisions
- 3 of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.
