AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF PHYSICIAN FOR THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The position of physician for the school depart-
2 ment in the city of Marlborough shall be exempt from the provi-
3 sions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall not
2 impair the civil service status of any person holding the position of
3 school physician in the school department of the city of Marlbor-
4 ough on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the majority of the Senate in joint session, on the 18th day of November, 1881.

SECTION 1. The position of alderman for the school district in the City of Baltimore shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws shall not apply to any person holding the position of school physician in the school department of the City of Baltimore on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
