AN ACT

Relative to the Report of the Attorney-General.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The attorney-general shall annually make
2 a report to the general court of the business of his office
3 during the preceding year, with such suggestions and
4 recommendations as to the amendment and the proper
5 and economical administration of law as he may deem
6 expedient.

1 SECTION 2. Section nine of chapter seventeen of the
2 Public Statutes is hereby repealed.
