AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FILLING OF VACANCIES IN THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF WEBSTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 11 of chapter 155 of the acts of 1893 is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following sentence: — If there is any vacancy  
4 in said board, the remaining members shall give written notice  
5 thereof to the selectmen, who, with the remaining member or  
6 members of said board shall, after one week's notice, fill such  
7 vacancy by ballot. A majority of the ballots of the officers  
8 entitled to vote shall be necessary to such election. The person  
9 so elected to fill such vacancy shall perform the duties of the  
10 office until the next annual town meeting or until a member  
11 elected thereat is qualified.
