Decision

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether the licensee Chen & Ching, Inc. dba The Imperial Kitchen violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) permitting an illegality on the licensed premises to wit: Ch. 138, §34 sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age.

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the investigators report and the Commission finds said facts contained therein. This violation was found pursuant to a sting operation conducted by the ABCC and MADD. Investigator Mark Kenny testified that pursuant to a sting operation, the operative a 17 year old, purchased a Bud Beer in the amount of \$2.50. The operative was not carded by the licensee.

The Commission finds the licensee in violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises to wit: Ch. 138, §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. The Commission herein suspends the licensee's license for a period of 6 days.
