AN ACT

To change the Name of the Harrell Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of the Harrell Manu-

3 der the general laws of the Commonwealth, is
4 hereby changed to J. J. Warren Company.
