

By Mr. Wetmore, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1408) of Robert D. Wetmore for legislation to provide relief to the town of Monson for damages caused by the storm of May twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine. Ways and Means.

AN ACT PROVIDING RELIEF TO THE TOWN OF MONSON FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY THE STORM OF MAY 24TH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for disaster relief and to meet the
2 expenses of public services incurred as a result of the storm which
3 severely struck the town of Monson on May 24th, nineteen
4 hundred and eighty-nine, the sum set forth in section two is
5 hereby appropriated, subject to the provisions of law regulating
6 the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining
7 to appropriations in chapter 240 of the acts of nineteen hundred
8 and eighty-nine.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 240 of the Acts of 1989 is
2 hereby amended by inserting after line item 1599-3809 the
3 following item: —

1599-3810 For the purpose of providing emergency disaster relief relating
to the damage caused by the storm which struck the town
of Monson on May 24th nineteen hundred and eighty-nine
including but not limited to the extraordinary costs and
expenses associated with necessary clean up and disposal
of debris to alleviate the danger and emergency posed by
damaged and downed trees and limbs along public streets
and ways, and in the waterways of Massachusetts. Said
reimbursement shall include the expense or overtime costs
for public employees, the cost of hired and purchased
equipment and crews 117,458.05

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
