AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF SOUTHBOROUGH TO TAKE WATER FOR WATER SUPPLY PURPOSES FROM THE SUDBURY RESERVOIR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Southborough is hereby authorized to
2 take water for water supply purposes of said town and
3 its inhabitants from that part of the metropolitan
4 water system known as Sudbury reservoir at such
5 times as water may be available in said reservoir
6 and as water is not being taken by said town from the
7 pressure aqueduct and tunnel of the metropolitan
8 water system, as authorized by any provisions of law;
9 provided, that said town is hereby authorized to take
10 four hundred thousand gallons of water per day from
11 said reservoir without charge.
