### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN SOLDIERS HOMES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of trustees of the Soldiers' Home in  
2 Massachusetts and the board of trustees of the Sol-  
3 diers' Home in Holyoke are hereby authorized and  
4 directed to extend hospital facilities to any person  
5 in the armed forces of the United States while the  
6 United States is engaged in hostilities under the flag  
7 of the United Nations, and to admit therein for medi-  
8 cal and surgical care and treatment any such person  
9 or any person who has served as aforesaid and was  
10 honorably discharged from said service.
