AN ACT AUTHORIZING WORK ACTIVITIES FOR VANDALISM OFFENDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws as most recently amended
2 by Chapter 544 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby amended by
3 inserting at the end of section 127 the following new sen-
4 tence: —

5 In lieu thereof, the court may, in its direction and with the
6 consent of the offender, require that the offender do work or
7 participate in activities of a type and for a period of time
8 deemed appropriate by the court.
