### R E S O L V E

In favor of Solomon C. Howland, Treasurer of the District of Marshpee.

*Resolved*, For reasons set forth in the petition of the selectmen of the district of Marshpee, that there be allowed and paid from the treasury of the Commonwealth to Solomon C. Howland, treasurer of the district of Marshpee, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars, the same to be expended by said treasurer, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the completion of a road laid out by the county commissioners of the county of Barnstable: *provided*, that said Howland shall make a return of the expenditure of this money in his next annual report to the legislature; and *provided, further*, that no part of this appropriation shall be paid until a certificate signed by said county commissioners, to the effect that said road has been completed and accepted by them, shall be filed with the treasurer of the Commonwealth.
