The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

1 *Ordered*, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by adding
2 after Rule 5A the following new rule:

3 Rule 5B. The Senate shall adopt the permanent rules by which
4 it shall govern itself no later than the first Wednesday in February
5 at the beginning of each biennial session. The Senate shall adopt
6 its rules only by roll call vote. This rule shall not be suspended.

(Passed January 26, 1922 - Offered by Senate March 1, 1922)

The Constitution of Massachusetts

As the Same Has Been Amended by the Legislature

Ordered, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by adding after Rule 2A the following new rule:

Rule 2B. The Senate shall accept the form transmitted by which a bill governs itself on any day in the Winter Session or at the beginning of each biennial session. The Senate shall accept in this case by roll call vote. The vote shall not be suspended.
