AN ACT REQUIRING MANUFACTURERS AND DISTRIBUTORS OF FOOD AND FOOD PRODUCTS TO INDICATE THE CHOLESTEROL COUNT CONTAINED IN ANY FOOD PRODUCT OFFERED FOR SALE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 305C of chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the second sentence thereof the  
3 following sentence:— Such certificate of registration shall only  
4 be valid so long as such person indicates the cholesterol count  
5 of the food product manufactured, distributed or offered for  
6 sale.
