AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE TIME FOR FILING APPLICATIONS  
FOR ABATEMENTS FOR TAX AND OTHER ASSESSMENTS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide an extension of time for filing a sewer betterment assessment abatement for agriculture and forest land, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 580  
2 of the Acts of 1980, nor the provisions of any other general  
3 or special law to the contrary, Chapter 216 of the acts of 1974,  
4 as amended by Chapter 210 of the Acts of 1979, is hereby  
5 amended by striking out the following in Section 1: "January  
6 thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty;" and inserting in  
7 place thereof, the following: "January thirty-first, nineteen  
8 hundred and eighty-five."

9 Said Chapter is also hereby amended by striking out the fol-  
10 lowing in Section 2: "August first, nineteen hundred and sev-  
11 enty-five;" and inserting in place thereof, the following: "Jan-  
12 uary thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-five."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July thirty-first,  
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
