AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSPECTORS OF WIRES IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 33 the following section: —
3 *Section 33A.* No inspector of wires shall inspect
4 or approve electrical work done by himself, his em-
5 ployer, employee or one employed with him, but in a
6 city or town subject to section thirty-two, shall in
7 the manner provided therein appoint an additional
8 inspector of wires, who shall inspect electrical work
9 so done. Said additional inspector may act in the
10 absence or disability of the local inspector, and for
11 his services shall receive like compensation. This
12 section shall not apply to any city or town establish-
13 ing an annual salary for the inspector of wires, and in
14 such city or town the inspector of wires shall not
15 engage in or work at the business of electrical work.
