## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

---

1     *Ordered*, That the Committee on Commerce and Labor be  
2 authorized to sit during the 1993 session of the General Court and  
3 during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of  
4 conducting an investigation and study of the occupational safety  
5 and health of public employees. Such investigation and study shall  
6 include, but not be limited to, an examination of safety standards,  
7 health hazards, the prevention of industrial accidents, enforce-  
8 ment mechanisms, etc.

9     Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State  
10 House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within  
11 the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other  
12 services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.  
13 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of  
14 its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,  
15 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
16 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of  
17 the Senate on or before the first Wednesday in December, nineteen  
18 hundred and ninety-three.
