AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRISTOL COUNTY TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO J. F. NACAULA & SONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the county
2 commissioners of Bristol county are hereby authorized to pay
3 out of any funds in the treasury of the county of Bristol to J.
4 F. Nacaula & Sons, South Main street, Assonet, Massachusetts,
5 an unpaid bill in the sum of one thousand twelve dollars and
6 fifty cents (\$1,012.50) for excavation work in connection with
7 a contract for the emergency installation of new water service
8 at the Fall River Superior Courthouse on December eleven,
9 nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
