AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPUTING SENIORITY UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE
LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 39 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 393 of the Acts of 1978, as hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence, the following sen-
4 tence: The time employed in provisional or temporary status be-
5 fore permanent appointment in the departmental unit shall be
6 considered by the appointing authority in deciding which perman-
7 ent employees in the same title with the same civil service seniority
8 date shall be separated from service pursuant to this section.
