AN ACT CLARIFYING THE DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN CHIROPODY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 251 of the acts of 1938 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:— The Massachusetts school of
3 chiropody, formerly known as the Beacon institute
4 of podiatry, whose present name was adopted under
5 general law on January twenty-third, nineteen hun-
6 dred and fifty-two, is hereby authorized and em-
7 powered to grant the degree of doctor of chiropody
8 or podiatry to students properly accredited and
9 recommended by a majority of its trustees and faculty;
10 provided, that the course of instruction required for
11 such degree shall occupy not less than four years and
12 shall be approved by the approving authority estab-
13 lished under section sixteen of chapter 112 of the
14 General Laws.
